## PROFESSOR ANTONIA MOROPOULOU DECORATED AT THE PATRIARCHATE

On Tuesday, the 4<sup>th</sup>/17<sup>th</sup> of March 2015, Ms Antonia Moropoulou, Seismology Professor at the National Technical University of Greece, and the Studies' Director of the "Materials and Conservation Interventions" Direction, visited the Patriarchate on an invitation to assess the state of preservation of the Aedicula of the Holy Sepulcher, following the recent unauthorized intervention of the Israeli Police and the Israeli Archaeological Service.

On the occasion of this visit, His Beatitude bestowed upon Prof. Moropoulou the honourary distinction of Supreme Taxiarch of the Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulcher, in recognition of her scientific contribution, both past and present, to the Patriarchate and the Holy Sepulcher.
