The Minister thanked His Beatitude for his visit to the Church of the Holy Sepulchre the previous day, and asked His blessing for his forthcoming visit to the Minister of Agriculture of Israel and to the King of Jordan.

On this occasion, His Beatitude offered the Minister an icon

of the Theotokos and the renovated Sacred Edicule, while the Minister offered Him in return an emblem depicting the three nationalities which live in the Democracy of Srpska.
